Participation is open to all students who are enrolled full-time at the Primarily Undergraduate Institutions participating in the WV-INBRE who will have not graduated by August 2014.

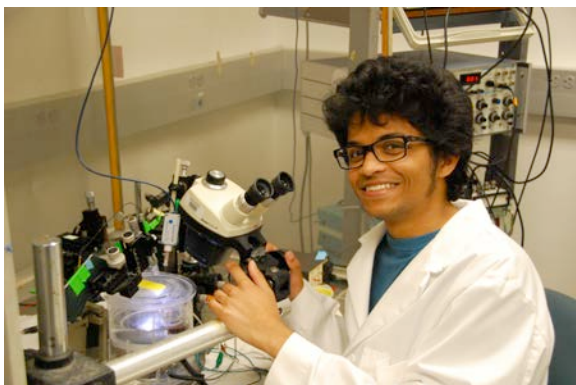


Research Opportunities:

- Academic record, particularly in science courses
- Laboratory experience
- Stated interest in biomedical research and career goals, and why would like to participate in the program
- Recommendations of two faculty members at the applicant's institution and others, if relevant



Application process:

- Completed application form (<http://www.wv-inbre.net/summerprogram/>)
- Transcripts from all institutions of higher learning attended
- Two letters of recommendation

- ✚ \$4,500 stipend
- ✚ Conduct research in state-of-the-art facility
- ✚ Present results of the research project at the WV-INBRE Summer Research Symposium

- ✚ Presentations on topics related to research and graduate education such as: faculty research activities, career opportunities, research ethics, scientific presentations, and more

- ✚ Dates of Summer Internship are May 27st through July 28th
- ✚ Applications and supporting documents must be received on or by **February 14, 2014**
